150 guests attended the dinner, including many prominent businessmen from Sydney's Greek community. 40 thousands dollars was raised on the night on the back of a very successful live auction.

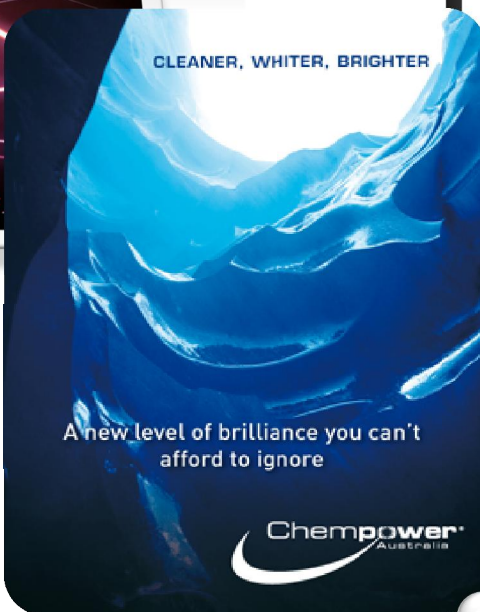
