About Greenacre Area Community Centre

Greenacre Area Community Centre (GACC) is a not-for-profit community organisation offering a range of services and programs to the local communities of Greenacre, Chullora, Mt Lewis and the wider Canterbury Bankstown Local Government Area.

GACC has been in operation since 1997. It became an Incorporated Association in 2002, under the name Greenacre Area Neighbourhood Centre Inc., changing its name in 2011 to Greenacre Area Community Centre to reflect the terminology more commonly used within the community.

Whilst programs and services have evolved over the years in response to community needs and the availability of funding, GACC has retained its focus on providing community capacity building programs for the whole community, with a particular focus on children, young people, families, and people who are socially isolated or disadvantaged.

GACC has built strong local networks and collaborates with other agencies to increase community access to services. We are members of the Canterbury Bankstown Domestic Violence Committee and our staff sit on various other committees and community interagencies.

The **governing body** of GACC is a **volunteer Management Committee** comprised of local residents or workers who are professionals with the requisite skills and a strong commitment to locally-based community services. The Management Committee is elected by the Centre's membership at our Annual General Meeting or appointed by the Management Committee to fill casual vacancies when they arise.

Members' Commitment

- Attend and participate in monthly Management Committee meetings of approx. 2- hours duration
- Review monthly reports and other material provided, participate in discussions and contribute to quality decision making
- Attend any extra ordinary meetings as required

• Office Bearers may be required to perform other duties such as signing of documents, minute taking, meeting with funding bodies, attending cheque presentations etc.

Application Process

Anyone interested in joining the Management Committee should apply for membership of the Greenacre Area Community Centre if not already a member. Please complete the "Application for Centre Membership" form and "Application to Join the Management Committee" form attached to this document. Your application will be tabled at the next Management Committee meeting for approval. The applicant can, if they wish, attend this meeting to discuss their application and meet the committee.

Following the committee meeting, the applicant will be notified of the outcome of their application and if successful will be invited to attend their first management committee meeting where an orientation to the service will be provided.
